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## POORLY MANAGED LAND

- A society facing aging and depopulation.
- Changes in address and family name and inheritance registration were NOT mandatory before 2023.



**INCREASE !** Poorly Managed Land  
Unidentified Landowners

**NEW LAW :** Vesting of burdensome inherited Land in the National Treasury

**AMENDMENTS :** Real Estate Registration Act and Civil Code

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



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## Reason 2: The Generation Gap

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
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## Act on the Vesting of Inherited Land in the National Treasury

Number of Applications and Breakdown of Approvals, Rejections, etc

Total: 3,500  
(Apr. 2023-Feb. 2025)



### Enforcement of the New Law (2023)

This Act creates a system that allows land that has been acquired by inheritance or through a bequest to an heir to be relinquished and vested in the National Treasury.

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
